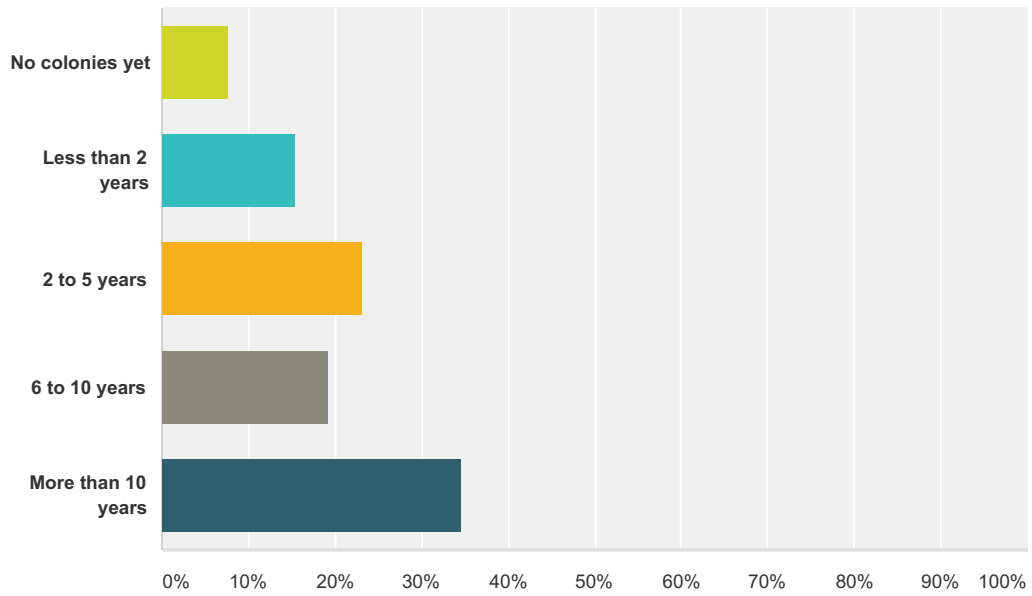


Q1 How many years have you been keeping bees?

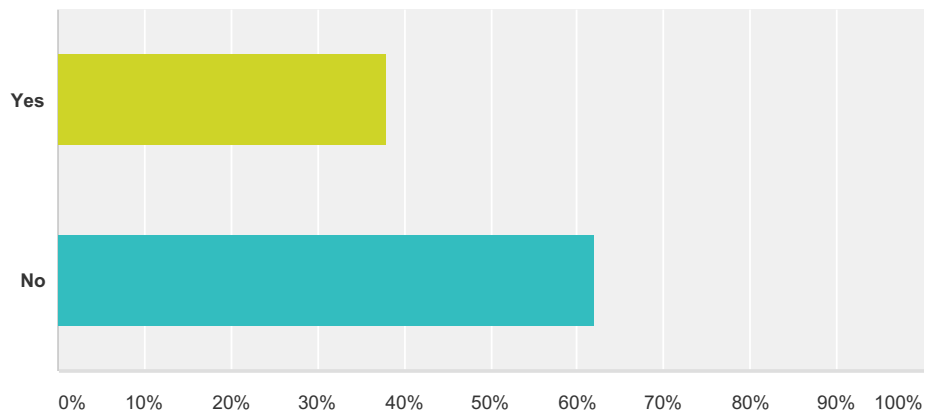

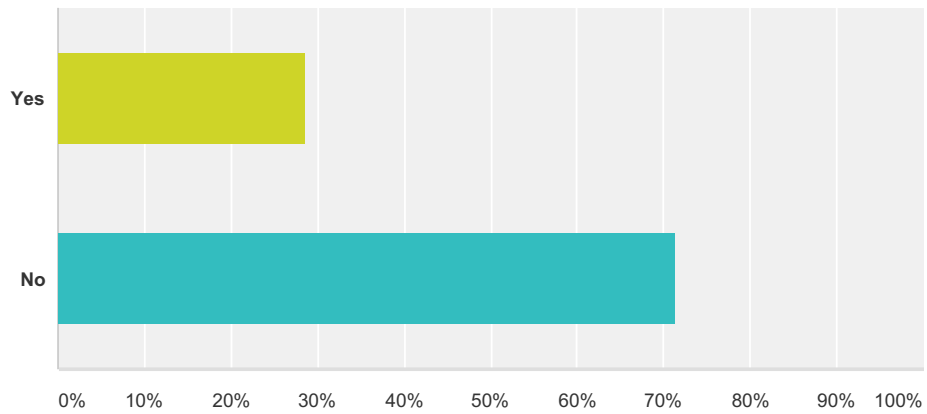

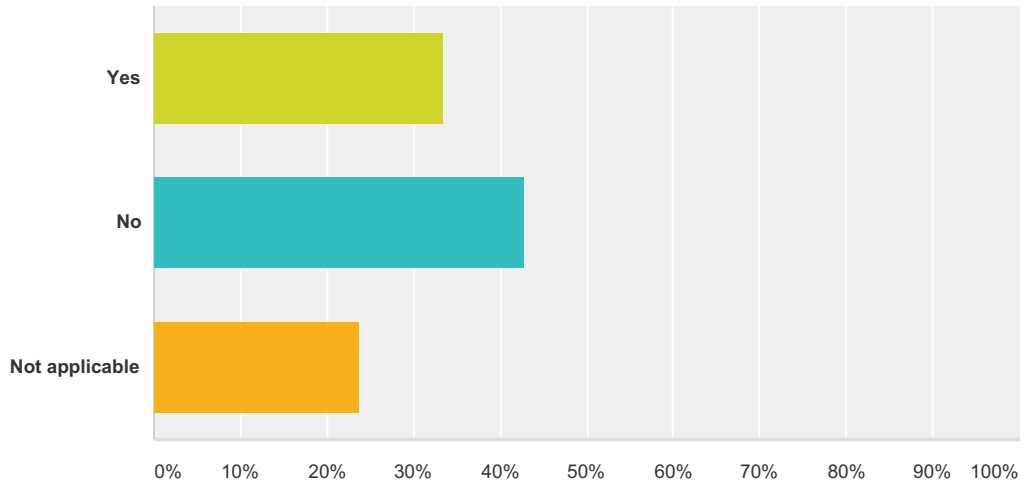

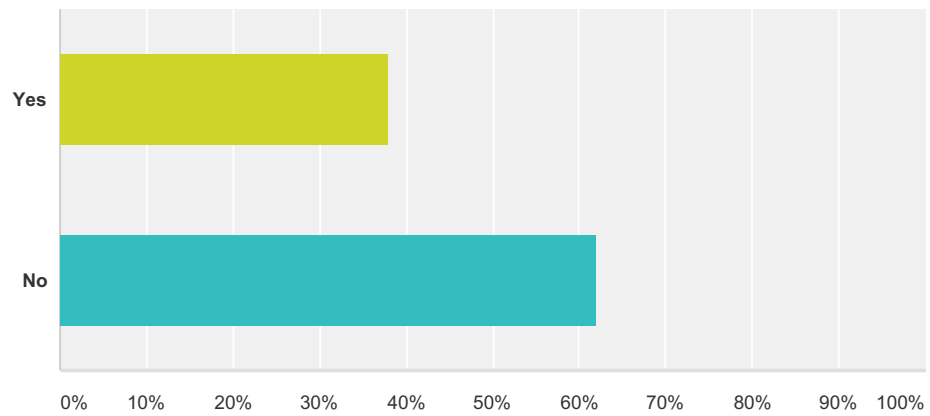

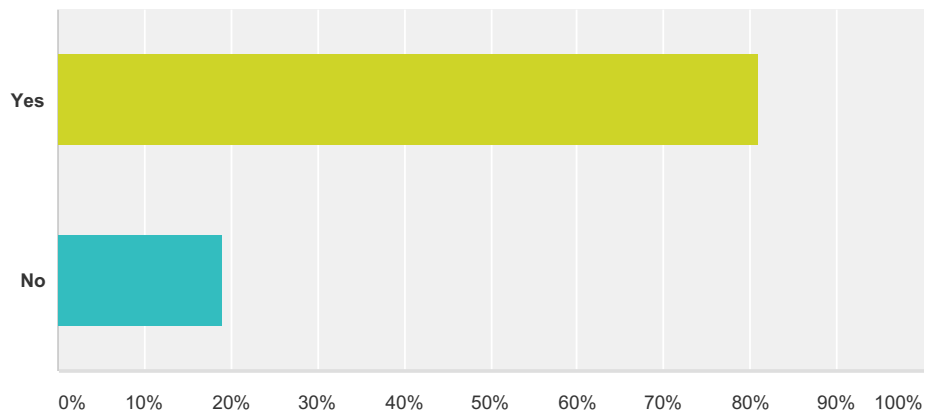

Q7 Would you be interested in purchasing honey jars, foundation and frames through an RBKA bulk purchasing scheme?

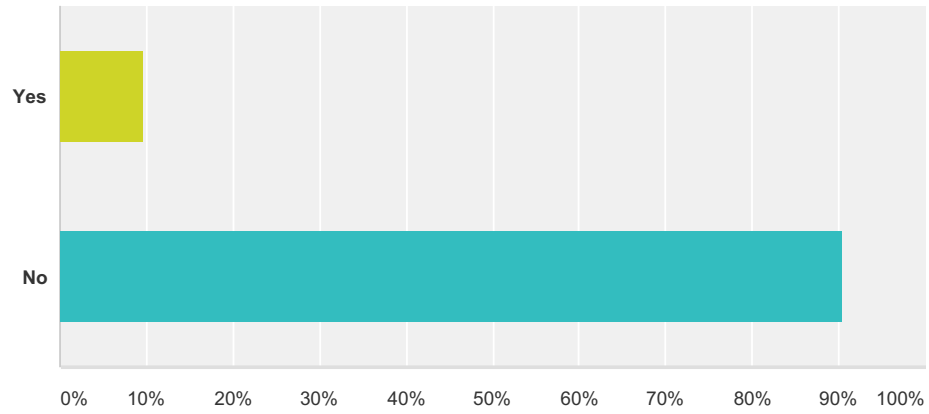

Q8 Are you interested in showing honey or bee products?

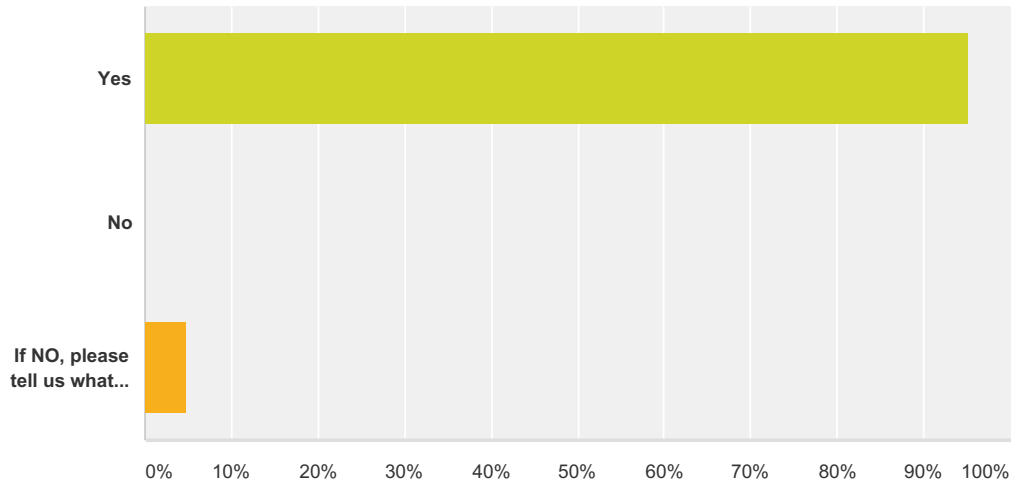

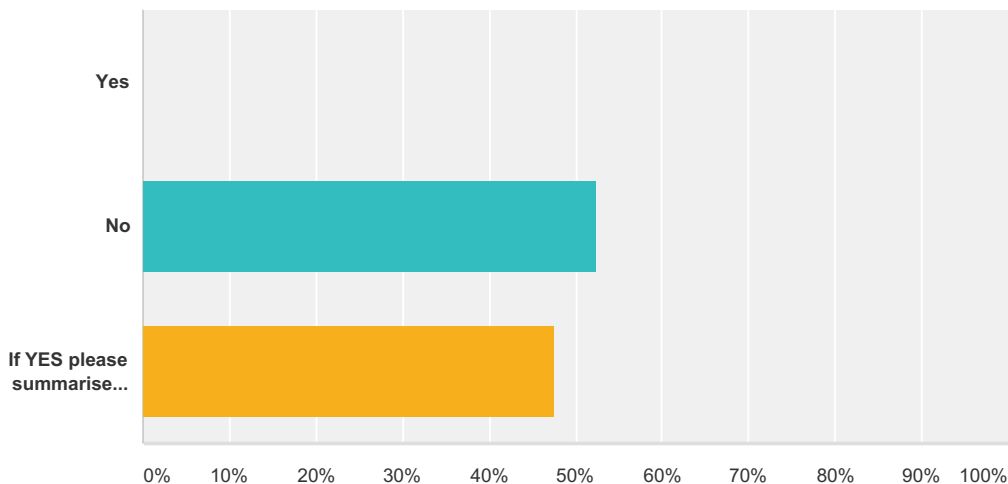

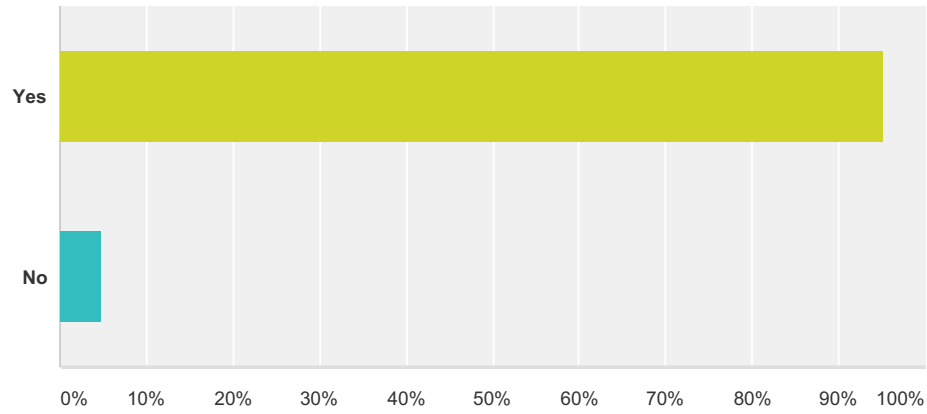

Q13 Do you plan to attend any of the summer apiary/practical sessions?

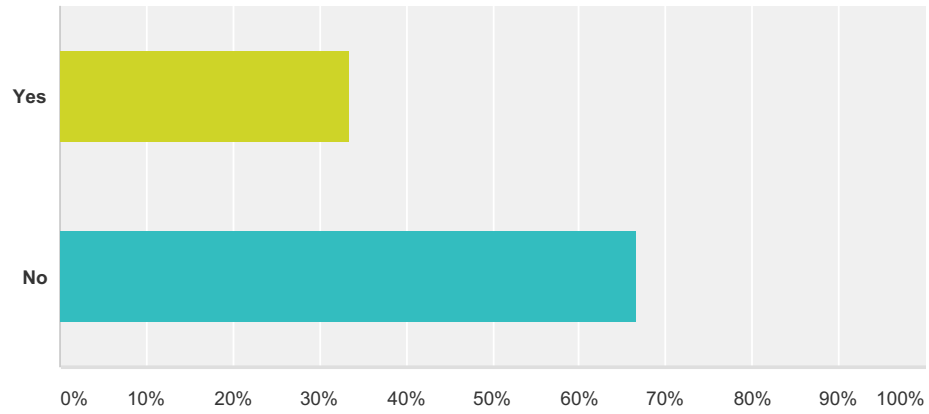

Q14 Would you be prepared to host a summer meeting at your apiary?

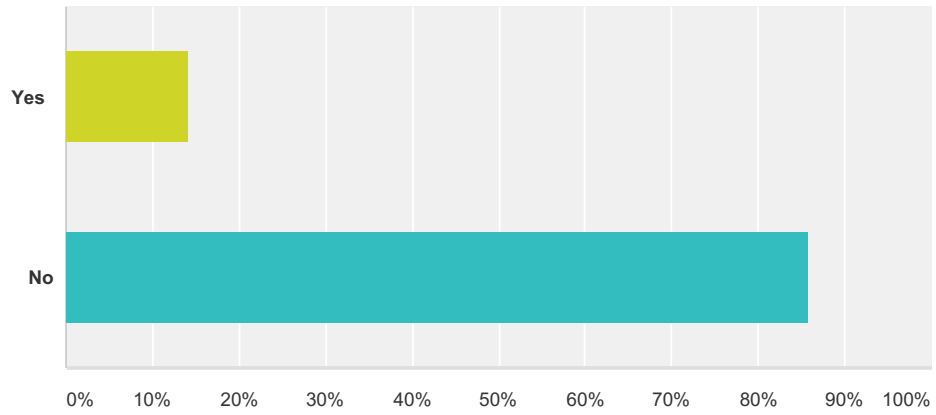

Q15 Would you be prepared to act as a Swarm Collector and be listed on the BBKA's website?

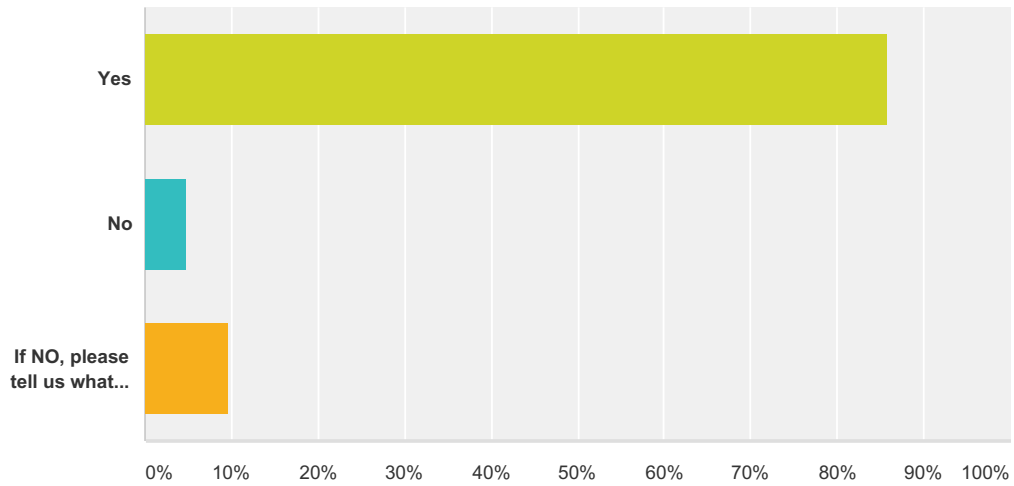
